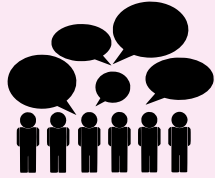
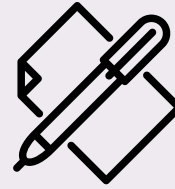


## Attend a branch meeting
